She is also frontwoman of heavy metal sensation, Judas Priestess, and the *only* singer to have a song with the artist they’ve tributed!

Militia made her Carnegie Hall debut in 2022 with “SuperYou! The Musical” and has performed Off-Broadway in “Everything Bad and Beautiful,” and toured in Dee Snider’s “Van Helsing’s Curse” (Lead Vocalist), “Rock of Ages” (Justice), “Rocky Horror Show” (Magenta *and* Columbia) and the European Tour of “Jesus Christ Superstar.” She is an award-winning solo artist, songwriter/composer, filmmaker, AR/VR/XR/ immersive creator. Militia hosted Fuse’s “Heavy Metal Makeover” and VJed on MTV2, Vh1 and MuchMusic USA. Militia is in books and films, including the epic documentary “BETTY: They Say I’m Different” about the life of funk rock legend, Betty Davis (Amazon Prime Video.) In recent news, her cover of Led Zeppelin’s “FRIENDS” by Patriarchs in Black (with Johnny Kelly of Type O Negative, Danzig and Quiet Riot) ft. Militia Vox was just named “Top 10: Best of 2023” on Sirius XM’s Liquid Metal.
